




Amerton Railway



Built by W.G.Bagnalls of Stafford works No. 1491. Isabel worked at Cliffe Hill Granite quarry in Leicestershire and was delivered new on the 9th February 1897! After her hard working life she was brought back to W.G.Bagnall in Stafford and placed on a plinth outside the works at Castletown. She was moved onto another plinth in Victoria Park in 1963, after locomotive construction stopped at the Castletown works. By the 1980s she wasn't in a good state and a group of volunteers decided to restore her for her former glory. Amerton Railway was built specifically to run Isabel and she pulled her first passenger trains there in 1991!
