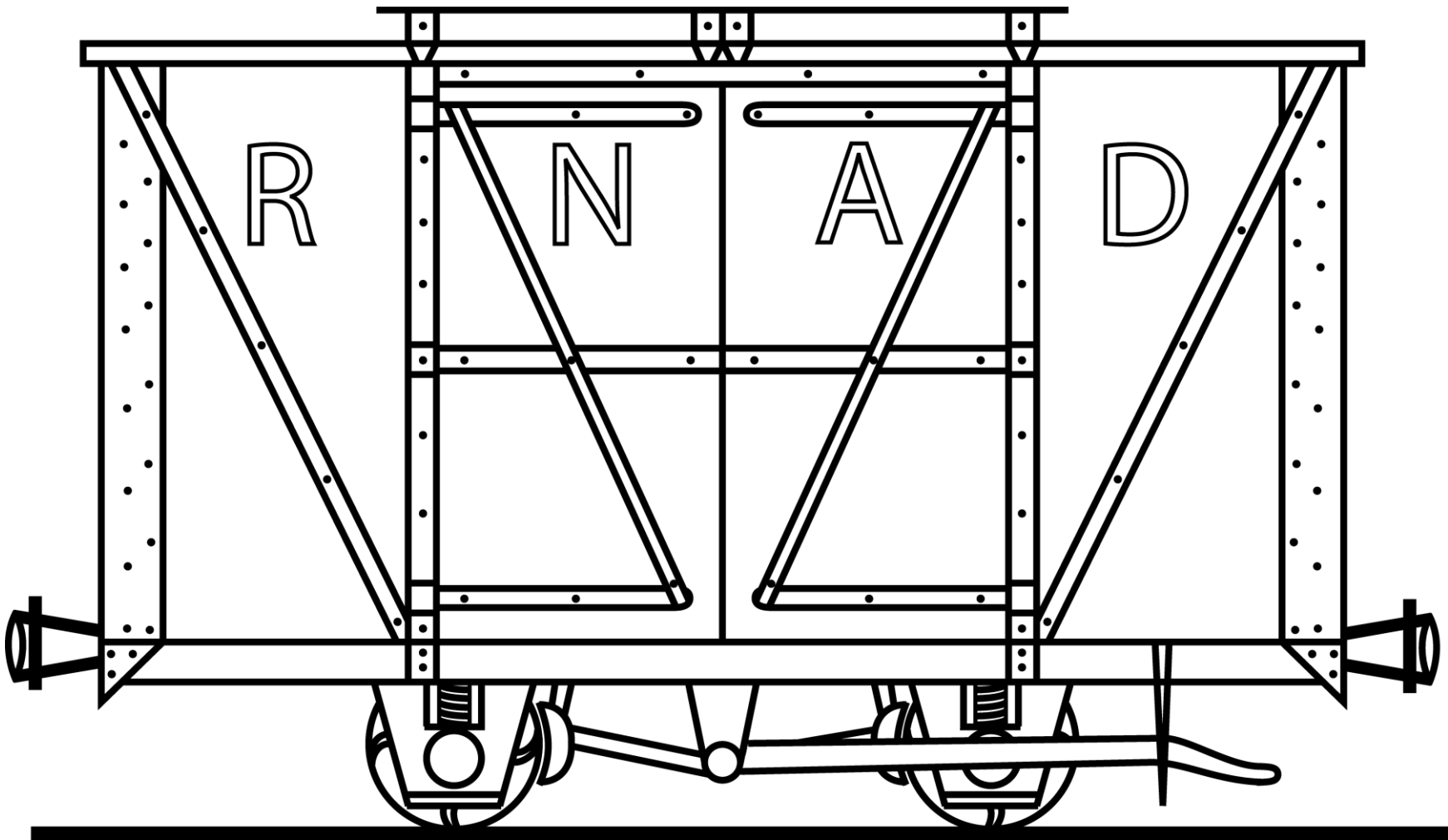


Amerton Railway



These wagons were originally based at RNAD (Royal Naval Armaments Depot) at Trecwn, south of Fishguard. RNAD Trecwn was an underground storage facility for munitions that consisted of 58 tunnels dug into the hillsides. These wagons would've been used to transport the munitions around the site. The sliding roof was to help to load the wagons, so the munitions could be lifted in. The flat wagons have two different lengths. It is thought that the longer wagons were for submarine torpedoes! Originally being 2 foot 6 inch gauge they have been re-gauged to 2 foot gauge to run here at Amerton, along with an excellent restoration we have a rake of wagons that look as good as new!
